Our Department of Internal Medicine - Oncology & Gastroenterology (Palliative Medicine and Diabetes) at the Park-Klinik Weissensee (academic teaching hospital of the Charité) has extensive expertise and a long history of providing medical care for international patients and their family members. We offer both outpatient and inpatient services, at the highest level of medical standards. Our international patients are accommodated in comfortable hospital rooms, equipped with balconies which give a magnificent view of the surrounding park. All of our comfort rooms are equipped with TV, radio, and internet access available around the clock. Our patients can select from a personalized menu including vegetarian and vegan foods. Family members or companions are also invited to stay in the same room, or a neighboring room if they choose to. A nearby Living-Hotel, where each apartment has its own kitchen, is also available to family members, companions and outpatients.

Transportation to and from the Park-Klinik is a breeze. With nearby public transport you can easily explore the city. Shuttles to and from the airport, or main train station are also available upon request.

A variety of small shops are located within walking distance in the vicinity of our hospital which you can easily explore.

Our services range from regular health check ups for diagnosis and treatment of rare diseases, with all modern medical technologies of the university teaching hospital at our disposal.

We provide an interdisciplinary second medical opinion in case of complex diseases and plan further treatments to be performed either in our hospital or in the patient's home country. The entire medical network of our teaching hospital is also available to our patients, so that all conceivable diseases can be treated.

We assist patients with visa and entry formalities, clarify the necessary medical services in advance, and thus create transparency even before entering Berlin. Our patients are accompanied by certified translators for the entire duration of treatment. At the end of the treatment, we conduct final consultations, hand out a discharge letter in German or English, as well as a medical certificate to ensure a problem free return home.

Our department is led by five senior physicians with a wide range of medical specialties, such as general internal medicine, gastroenterology, oncology, palliative medicine, diabetology, proctology, blood disorders, human genetic counseling and rheumatology. We work closely with the Department of Cardiology and Rheumatology to offer a comprehensive spectrum of internal medicine. Professor Strowski, Chief of the Internal Medicine Department, is an expert clinician with 13 years of experience in the cutting-edge university medicine in his past.

In the following you provide a detailed overview of our services, which we continuously improve, according to the latest medical standards.

The following organ examination and treatments are offered:

- Esophagus, stomach, duodenum (esophago-gastro-duodenoscopy, EGD)
- bowels, rectum and anus (colonoscopy, sigmoidoscopy and proctoscopy)
- Capsule endoscopy of the small intestine
- Intestinoscopy to detect small intestinal lesions (e. g. bleeding, polyps)
- Bronchoscopy (examination of the lungs)
- Drainage of the pleura
- Implantation of gastric tubes for feeding through the abdominal wall
- ERCP, PTCD of the bile ducts as well as the pancreas
- endoscopic treatment of benign and malignant tumors including full-thickness wall resection (FTRD)
- treatment of benign or malignant constrictions and stenoses in the gastrointestinal tract with stents, drains, balloon dilatation or radiofrequency ablation
- treatment of chronic bleeding using clips, injections, argon plasma coagulation, PuraStat as well as stent implantation
- Treatment of hemorrhoids and anal fissures
- treatment of varices (varicose veins) of the esophagus
- endosonography, including tissue sampling of abdominal organs
- acid measurement (pH) as the gold standard for the detection of reflux disease
- high-resolution pressure measurement (manometry) of the esophagus
- Lung function testing (spirometry, gas exchange measurement)
- Computer tomography (spiral CT), magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and X-ray examination of the entire gastrointestinal tract
- permanent or temporary drainage of abdominal fluid (ascites)
- treatment of surgical diseases in cooperation with the surgeons in the certified abdominal center
- chronic inflammatory bowel diseases (Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis)
- Treatment of chronic constipation (constipation)
- Comprehensive health check up
- Liver diseases
- Diabetes mellitus type 1 and type 2 (including pump therapy and implantation of sensors under the skin)
- Treatment of obesity
- Functional gastrointestinal diseases
- Food intolerances

In cooperation with the Department of Cardiology and Rheumatology:

ECG, echocardiography, stress echocardiography, cardio-CT/cardio-MRI, pulmonary function testing, joint ultrasound and cardiac catheterization, if necessary.

We work very closely with the Department of Park-Klinik Weißensee: General and Visceral surgery, Orthopedics and Trauma surgery, ENT, Gynecology, Neurology und Plastic surgery.



Oncology and Hematology:

We offer an interdisciplinary team of experts that includes oncologists, surgeons, gastroenterologists, radiologists, radiation oncologists and pathologists. We re-evaluate your samples, data, reports, images, including tissue samples, and decide on the best possible individual treatment options that are established at the interdisciplinary tumor conferences. A treatment can take place on an inpatient basis in our hospital or can optionally be coordinated and monitored by us in your home country.

The spectrum of multidisciplinary treatment of solid as well as hematological tumors includes the following neoplasms:

- gastrointestinal tract,
- lung,
- kidney,
- thyroid gland, lymph glands,
- hematopoietic and lymphatic system (lymphomas).

We offer in-patient chemotherapy, antibody therapy and immunotherapy, which are either based on up-to-date international standards or are individually designed, based upon the results of a comprehensive genetic analysis of the tumor biomarkers. Palliative concepts under the guidance of our palliative physicians are made with the cooperation of all relevant specialist disciplines and, if necessary, offered at our clinic.

Health check-up

Services include: Medical history, physical screening, determination of tumor markers, sonography, gastroscopy, colonoscopy, ECG, echocardiography and, if necessary, further examinations e.g. cardio-CT/cardio-MRI.
